



Posting 9-Hole Scores by 18-Hole Players

Scores to post

- if 13 or more holes are played, the player must post an 18-hole score
- if 7 to 12 holes are played, the player must post a 9-hole score
- in either case, unplayed holes shall be recorded as par plus handicap strokes

Scores in all forms of competition

- scores in both match play and stroke play must be posted for handicap purposes

Posting 9-hole scores

- the course must have a 9-hole NZ Golf Course Rating and Slope Number
- at least seven holes must be played
- no restriction on the number of 9-hole scores posted to a player's scoring record
- no restriction on courses to play - a score from a 9-hole course at one club can be combined with a score from a 9-hole course from the same or any other club

Treatment of 9-hole scores

- 9-hole scores are combined in the order they are received into the player's scoring record
- combined 9-hole scores will be designated with the letter 'C' (for example, 85C)
- an 18-hole score created by the combination of two 9-hole scores will display the date and course name (if applicable) of the latest 9-hole score (for example, 10.1.2010 and 6.2.2010 = 6.2.2010)
